Warrant Officer Class One Anthony Charles Toghill enlisted in the Australian Regular Army on 16th November, 1950. He was posted to 4th Battalion, The Royal Australian Regiment on 21st October, 1964 as a Company Sergeant Major. On 18th November, 1966 he was appointed Regimental Sergeant Major and moved with the 4th Battalion to South Vietnam, arriving on 1st June, 1968.

During his service in Vietnam as Regimental Sergeant Major, he displayed exceptional ability, professional competence, loyalty and devotion to duty in his demanding appointment.

He took an active part in operations, often commanding patrols himself. He was responsible for the defence of battalion headquarters and for its daily routine and accepted this and a multitude of other tasks enthusiastically. He showed outstanding attention to all his duties.

His demeanour, advice and guidance to junior officers, warrant officers and non-commissioned officers was exemplary.

Warrant Officer Toghill's fine example of the very best soldierly qualities earned the respect and admiration of all members of the battalion, both Australian and New Zealand. His achievements as Regimental Sergeant Major of an integrated Australian and New Zealand battalion reflect great credit upon him and have been a contributing factor to the harmony and co-operation enjoyed within the battalion in Vietnam.
